P & C would like donations of cakes and slices for the Athletics Carnival on tomorrow. If you can help please deliver to the Town Oval canteen on the day.

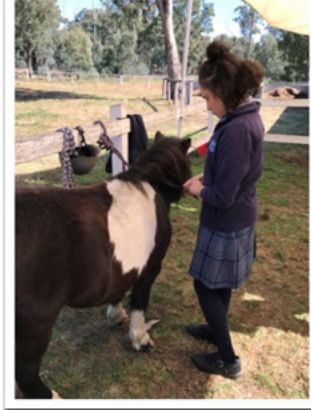

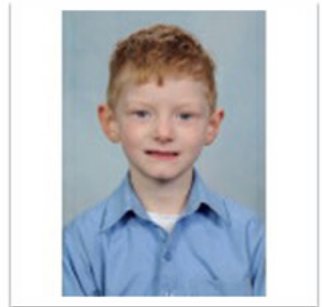


Before Winter, started, we had a lovely walk to Nelson Park and witnessed the beautiful colour changes of the Autumn leaves.
