Primary Spelling Bee

On Tuesday, August 7, 2018, Coonabarabran PS held their annual School Spelling Bee. Two sessions were held – one for Stage 2 and another for Stage 3. Students were selected to represent their classes in an intense spell-off.

Twenty-seven students entered the Stage 2 session, gradually getting eliminated as words like 'cherub', 'antique', 'apology' and 'museum' stumped the spellers. After five rounds, we had four students left: Lachlan Turner (3/4H), Zane Jenner (3/4W), Chelsea Rossler (3/4H) and Willem Ernest (3/4H). Lachlan dropped out in the sixth with the word 'deny', followed by Zane in the ninth round with the word 'explicit'. With a tight finish, Willem was runner up with the word 'sorcery', and Chelsea was made champion with the correct spelling of the words 'tedious' and 'unicycle'.

The Stage 3 session was eventful, with thirty-one students entered. There were many strong spellers remaining in the initial rounds, so in the fourth round, harder words were given and only seven remained in contention. In that next round, Hannah Evans (5/6L), Beau Hinton (5/6H) and Siarne Davis (5/6K) bowed out leaving Jolyon Somervaille, Tristan Nielsen, Camilla Ranken (all from 5/6L) and Brodie Regan (5/6H). Then the long process of deciding the winner commenced, with another thirteen rounds ensuing. At one point, Camilla was the only one who spelled the word correctly but the rules state that the winner must spell one more word correctly than the others and that was where she bombed out on the word 'altitude'. The final contestants returned and a constant merry-go-round for top position occurred with the final order being: equal third going to Brodie Regan ('collision') and Camilla; runner-up going to Jolyon ('prologue') and our Stage 3 champion, Tristan Nielsen, with the words 'mythology' and 'lexicon'.

All four winning students will be offered the opportunity to represent the school at the regional Spelling Bee held at Dubbo West Public on Thursday, September 13, 2018.

Congratulations on their efforts and we wish them success at the next level.

I wish to thank all the student participants for showing their marvellous spelling skills. I also thank the audience for respecting the rules and being attentive the whole session.
