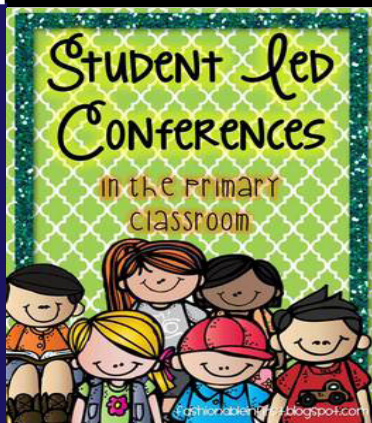

Meier's Magic Minute

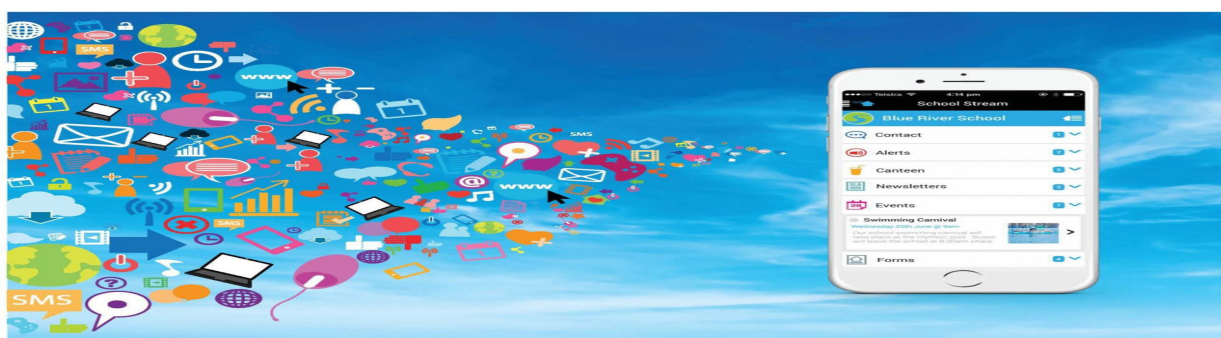

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With your support, we've had 15,000 schools and Early Learning Centres across Australia participate in this year's Earn and Learn. For the first time, we also had 120 Remote schools involved, which means that they will get to receive stickers to be used to earn equipment.

Thanks to the support, kids across Australia will get the new equipment they need to help develop the great minds of tomorrow.



With everyone's help we managed to raise 36840 points which is a fantastic effort!! Our items have been ordered and will arrive in Term 4.



There has been some changes made to our positive reward system this term. These changes include an introduction of a PBL level system. Each level is gained by collecting 10 stickers on their individual chart. A sticker is gained by a student collecting 10 shooting star tokens and trading with their teacher. When the rocket in the hall reaches the red level all children will receive their reward. The same process will then apply for each level.

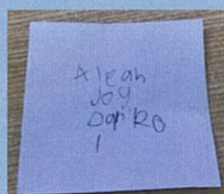
Coonabarabran Public School Free and Frequent Process



Students are given a shooting star tokens for displaying our school values. These can be given as a part of individual classroom positive behaviour strategies.



Students write their name on the back of their shooting star token and place in their class tub.



At stage assemblies, each class tips their tub into their stage canister. 4 names are drawn out per stage to receive a \$2 canteen voucher.



When stage canisters are full, a stage reward is given. This is to be completed by the following Wednesday after the assembly. Stage AP is to coordinate and send info to parents.

At stage assemblies, the full stage canister is to be emptied into the rocket for the whole school reward.

2 \$5 canteen voucher are to be drawn at whole school assemble

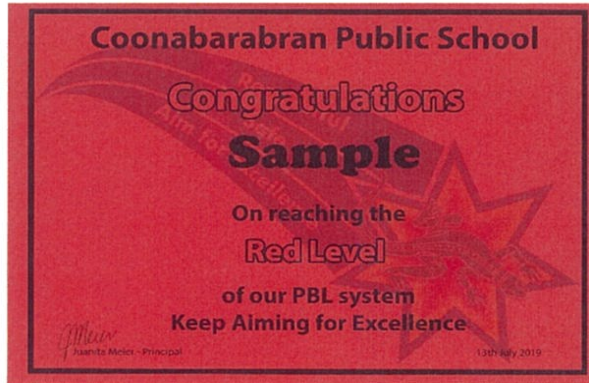


When the rocket reaches any level, all students on that level will receive a letter home, award at assembly notice in newsletter, and a positive on Sentral. When a student reaches:- **Red Level** a SRC games room / games afternoon. **Yellow level** chill time / gadget afternoon. **Orange level** a visit to the park. **Blue level** Morning tea with the Principal down town and group photo in newspaper.



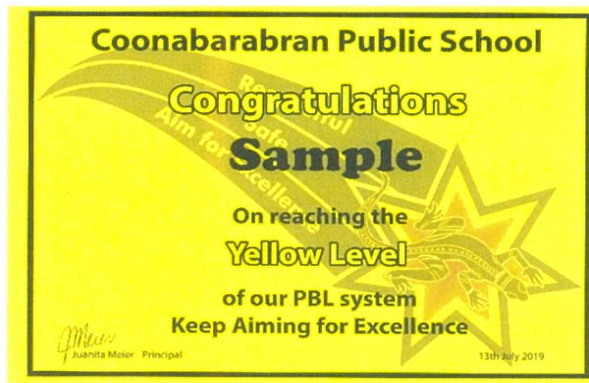

PBL LEVEL CERTIFICATES



Red Level

When a student reaches Red Level they will receive a letter home, an award at assembly and an afternoon session in the SRC Games room / games outside and a positive on Sentral.



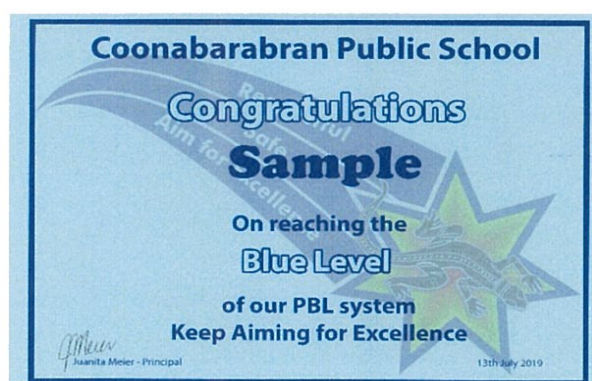
Yellow Level

When a student reaches Yellow Level they will receive a letter home, level awards placed into newsletter, an award at assembly and an afternoon session chill time / gadgets and a positive on Sentral.



Orange Level

When a student reaches Orange Level they will receive a letter home, awards notified on Facebook and school stream, an award at assembly, middle session at Nielson Park and a positive on Sentral.



Blue Level

When a student reaches Blue Level they will receive a letter home, group photo placed into the Town Newspaper, an award at assembly, morning tea with the Principal down town and a positive on Sentral.
