Coonabarabran Public School have introduced a Phone Intervention Program (PIP). This is an early and direct way to improve regular attendance and to build a positive relationship with parents in relation to school attendance.

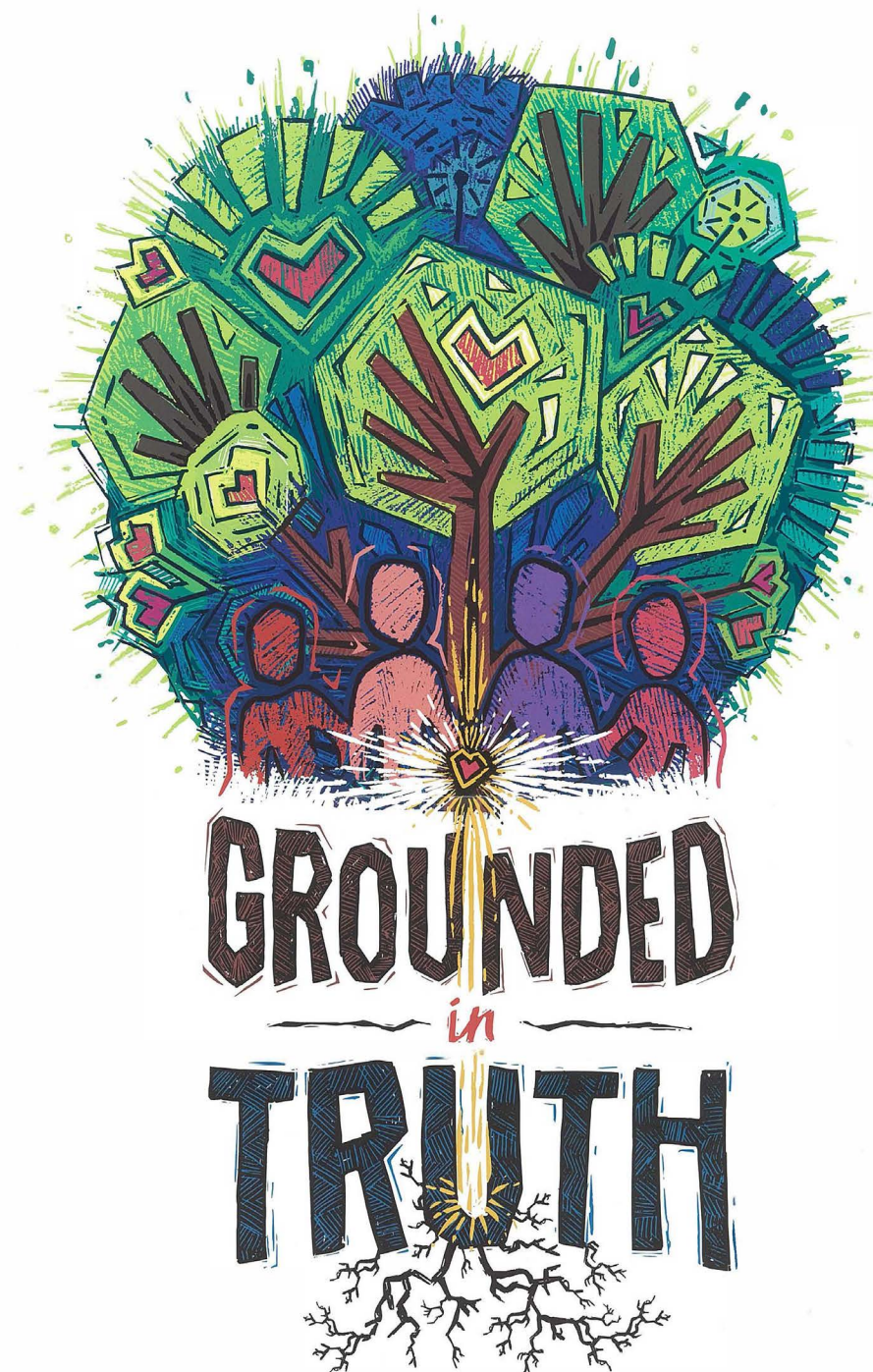
PIP involves contacting all parents of students who are absent on the day of the absence and getting the absence explained. This verbal explanation is then transferred on to the roll and there is no need to send a note in explaining the absences.

The Learning Support Teachers and Aboriginal Education Officer will make initial contact with parents each day in regard to student absences. They will contact the parent and record the reason for absence in the school attendance register.

Alternatively, if your child is absent all parents are welcome to phone the school office on 6842 1771 to explain the absence and the school attendance register will be completed accordingly.
