Dear Parent/Carers,

Students to return to school from Monday 13th September 2021

The Premier announced today that Stay-at-Home Orders in Warrumbungle Shire will be lifted as planned from 12.01am on Saturday 11th September 2021. This means students at Coonabarabran Public School will be welcome back to school from Monday 13th September 2021. Our school will be under Level 3 restrictions. This means:

- No Parents/Carers allowed onsite – please be mindful of congregating when picking up at the gate
- Events such as excursions and assemblies will NOT be allowed
- No scripture or community use of facilities
- No Early Birds Program
- Staff will be required to wear masks whilst onsite
- The school canteen will be operating
- If your child has flu-like symptoms they must stay at home and get a negative covid result before returning.

All students will be expected to attend school beginning Monday 13th September. Please send a water bottle with your child as bubblers will be NOT be in operation.

NO LEARNING FROM HOME PACKS WILL BE PROVIDED IF YOU CHOOSE TO KEEP YOUR CHILD AT HOME.

***** IMPORTANT *****

Please Read :

What does 'Level 3 School' mean?

Students must not attend school if unwell, even with mild symptoms of COVID-19. Any person with any COVID-19 symptoms must be sent home and not return to school unless:

- * they have isolated for 10 days, when no medical certificate is available
- * they have a negative COVID-19 test result and are symptom free.

In circumstances where children have other medical reasons for recurrent symptoms, a letter from their GP is sufficient to negate the requirement for a negative test.

Anyone who is unwell with COVID-19 symptoms is strongly encouraged to get tested and self-isolate until a negative result is received. Find your local testing clinics.

Mask wearing is optional for students in Primary School, all staff are required to wear masks indoors and outdoor settings.

Students are required to not mingle out of their class groups, therefore recess and lunch times will look a little bit different but will be at the same times.

The school canteen will operate however, there will be no purchasing over the counter. Students will order from their classrooms, lunches will be collected by staff and given to class groups. You can still order via phone to the office and pay by eftpos. A altered canteen menu will be available as we are only at school for a week before holidays.

Personal Hygiene and social distancing will be adhered to with each classroom given hand sanitiser and disinfectant wipes.

We ask that parents please maintain physical distancing by avoiding gathering outside the school gate, staff will walk students to gates at the end of the day for parents to pick up.

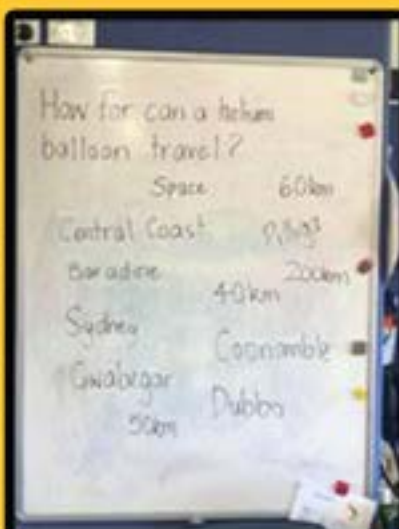
